# **JOB TRAINING**

### **Work Experience**

The Work Program is an opportunity for students to develop soft skills in a work environment. This allows them to acquire work experiences and build skills that will help them reach long-term employment goals.

### **Situational Assessment**

Situational Assessment services evaluate work-related skills using a controlled environment. This is typically accomplished at a job site using real-work experiences. The individual receiving services may be assessed in various work situations.

# Short-Term, On-The-Job Supports

Short-Term is provided for individuals who require additional training and support in order to learn job skills and maintain employment.

# **Supported Employment**

Supported Employment services assist the person supported in acquiring and maintaining competitive employment in an integrated work setting. Supports may include evaluation, job analysis, job matching, job placement, job training, job stabilization, and professional development.

# **Trial Work Experience**

Trial Work Experience assesses a person's abilities and capabilities, and matches them with a work experience of his or her choice.

# **Job Development and Placement**

Job Development and Placement services assist the person in attaining employment, and assisting the person in developing the essential work skills needed for maintaining employment.

# **Customized Employment**

Customized Employment is a flexible process designed to personalize the employment relationship between a job candidate and an employer that meets the needs of both. It is based on an individualized match between the strengths, conditions, and interests of a job candidate and the identified business needs of an employer.
